Sankhya Logic" by G. Srinivasan "...Mathematical expressions can be seen as a concise means of



transmitting knowledge, as formulations, devoid of ambiguities.

Any mathematical process by itself is not based on absolute logic

but forms a tool to augment logical explanations, which again depends on the skill of the investigator to find ways to use it meaningfully."

Mr. Srinivasan explains the intersection of Einstein's concepts and Sankhya's logic of unified theory and they are relevant in understanding the universe we exist in.
